### **Re: Learning remotely**

**1) Closing the schools is an extraordinary measure taken to protect our community.** This is not a vacation from school, and aside from doing your job as a student, you have an important job to do as a community member. Please make sure you are following all public health measures and do your best to keep our community safe. The better we are at being safe, the sooner we can get back to school in-person.

**2) This is different from our scenario last year.** This is a temporary pivot to remote learning, and when it is safe we will be returning to in-person classes. This is the plan for the next seven school days.

**3) We will be keeping a regular schedule and teaching LIVE online.** However, classes will just be running in the morning. The afternoons should be used by students to complete the work in preparation for the next day.

**4) We will be delivering learning online.** From last year's experience, we know that paper packages, by and large, did not work.
